Our annual Best of awards honor those venues (and the people behind them) that turn "no" into "yes" on a daily basis and still have the time and patience to deliver exceptional customer service.







90 Years YOUNG

A look back at Kansas City's treasured Midland Theatre

Kansas City may be known for its history of jazz, barbecue, and baseball, but the one place that everyone loves to call home is the historic Arvest Bank Theatre at The Midland, which celebrates its incredible 90th anniversary in 2017. Originally called the Midland Theatre, it opened in October 1927 as a thriving silent motion picture theater—the third largest in the country at the time—seen in the picture here.

As trends have changed over the years, the building has transformed into a professional bowling stadium, traditional movie theater, and now a concert venue operated by AEG Presents and the Cordish Company, after a multimillion-dollar renovation. Placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1977, the building still bears many of the original French-Italian Baroque design details, including 500,000-plus feet of gold leaf, five giant Czechoslovakian handcut crystal chandeliers, and a room made entirely of Tiffany glass tiles.





THE AGENDA food for thought



Butternut Squash Soup

As winter approaches, few things are more comforting than a piping hot bowl of soup. Oak Ridge Hotel & Conference Center knows that all too well, since the venue is based in Minnesota where the temps can dip into single digits (or colder) during the season. To warm guests up, they serve this hearty butternut squash soup, made with kitchen staples and a dash of fresh herbs.

INGREDIENTS:

10 lbs. butternut squash ½ cup honey
1.5 gal. chicken stock

1.5 gal. chicken stock3 shallots, thinly sliced

1 cup butter 1 cup flour

rosemary sprigs salt & pepper, to taste

TO PREPARE:

- 1. Cut squash in half, clean out, and smear with honey.
- 2. Roast squash in oven at 350 degrees for one hour, until soft.
- 3. In pot, melt butter, add sliced shallots, and sauté until tender.
- 4. Add flour to pot and stir continuously.
- 5. Add 1/3 of the stock and keep stirring.
- 6. Add cooked squash, the remaining ²/₃ of the stock, and rosemary sprigs. Simmer for 45 minutes.
- 7. Add salt and pepper to taste.

- 8. Remove rosemary, pour mixture in blender, and puree.
- 9. Return mixture to a pot over heat, and add rosemary back in.
- 10. Simmer for 15 minutes.
- 11. Season to taste. Makes 2 gallons. uv

Room for Rent

As hotel rates continue to climb, campuses are stepping in with an abundance of availability for leisure travelers.

It's the phenomenon sweeping every major city: Hotel rates are going up. In Chicago, the average per diem has increased by 16.8 percent from 2015 to 2016; in D.C., it's 12.5 percent; and even in Jackson, Mississippi, rates have gone up by 11.9 percent (all the findings according to a study by Business Travel News published last March).

As hotel rates continue to climb, people are checking out—and looking into other options for overnight accommodations. And that has set college and university campuses up nicely with a supply of sometimes thousands of beds in residence halls to meet growing demand for more affordable options.

"Price is probably our best advantage,

especially when someone is looking for a deal," says Cliff Fielder, conference services manager at Western University in London, Ontario, which currently has 500 single rooms, 3,000 double rooms, and 900 suites available across campus for \$65 a day, seven days a week when school is not in session (early May to mid-August). With such a large unused allot-

ment, the university has started to aggressively go after leisure solo travelers and families looking for competitive rates in a central location. "We recognized about three years ago that we have an incredible inventory of space available, so why not go out and promote and try to sell it?" he says. "It's a lucrative segment for us with continual double-digit growth."

At Western, Fielder says residence halls operate much like a hotel with beds (and basic linens) and breakfast that can be arranged for groups. He and his team have particularly been successful in catering to visitors of a nearby hospital that may need to find last-minute options.

"We are pretty close to our university hospital, and have been able to offer family stays for people that are visiting for the short-term but need beds for a number of unexpected nights," he notes.

At Thunderbird Executive Inn and

Conference Center in Glendale, Arizona (a unit of the Arizona State University Knowledge Enterprise), the property tends to attract both business travelers and leisure travelers including NFL football fans coming in for Arizona Cardinals games as well as guests attending MLB's Spring Training season every year.

"Our guests like the quiet atmosphere and close proximity to sporting events and shopping, and they're not afraid to try a non-traditional hotel—not just for cost savings but also the experience that is memorable," says Patti Davidson, regional general manager of the property that has 120 single rooms and 14 doubles that range from \$69-200 a night and are available year-round.

The inn and conference center is located on the campus of ASU's Thunderbird School of Global Management, which dates back to World War II when it was used as a fighter training base. Today, many black-and-white photos illustrating that history decorate the rooms and common areas, adding to the property's charm. Davidson also believes that the individualized service at a campus is part of its success. "What's unique about being at a university is that we know how to treat the customer with exceptional service and amenities, and they grow to love and appreciate that."

Though the Thunderbird Executive Inn and Conference Center has been open since 1996, it was in 2005 that a turning point came when the property retained FLIK Hospitality Group as a management company, "allowing us to strongly market to leisure travelers," says Davidson. "We really started to see an uptick in the transient market in 2012 and realized we could compete in the standard business market. Our business travelers have liked the resort-style atmosphere we have to offer and also the fact that we haven't had to compromise on amenities they expect

from a corporate hotel."

At the University of Hartford in West Hartford, Connecticut, the influx of residence housing over the summer has provided a unique opportunity to go after interns.

"We are right in the insurance capital of the country. A number of companies like Cigna, Prudential, and The Hartford are literally all in our backyard," says Director of Conference Services Heather Canny. "It's a really good market to tap into since they are all right here."

At this campus, there are 20, four-person suites with kitchen, living room, and separate bathrooms available for varying rates from late May until mid-August.

"We always had a speckling of interns, but three summers ago, we decided to be proactive and invested efforts to get larger contracts as opposed to just one-off visitors," says Canny, noting that The Hartford Insurance Company is their largest client with a contract for 20-plus interns that was recently renewed for a third year.

"It's a very pretty campus, and a nice place for them to live, but we do have competition from apartment buildings in downtown Hartford that have intern housing. They are more like luxury apartments, but also a tier or two pricewise above us," Canny adds, saying that her team's strategy for new business is to market what they do have. "We are price-conscious, safe, and have a lot of outdoor space. Plus a membership to our sports center comes with every rental. We also have complimentary parking on campus and free laundry."

Of course there are challenges—in the case of the University of Hartford it's their late time window (beds don't open up until closer to Memorial Day and are unavailable as of the second week in August). At Thunderbird Executive Inn & Conference Center it's visibility. "Finding our location can be a challenge because we don't have a branded name out on the street; we are located within

a campus without our own drive," says Davidson. There's also no standalone restaurant so guests have to share dining venues with the student body. It's a similar situation at Western, says Fielder. "We have to let people know that there's a potential of conference groups being there and some students that stay and do summer classes. They also have to realize that we don't have active food and beverage like a hotel." But he and Davidson say as long as they are upfront with guests about the environment they don't seem to mind in the long run.

And so far the future looks good. Almost all of the properties interviewed have moved on from just simply registering guests through their own website platforms and have started making rooms available on third party travel websites like Hotwire, Booking.com, Travelocity, and Expedia.

In fact, Davidson says Thunderbird's third party online reservations have grown 26 percent from the 2015-16 fiscal year to date. "That's up more than \$340,000 for us," she says, "strictly by getting our name out there." A big part is also the reviews, she says. "We pride ourselves on having all reviews responded to, good or bad, so people know what they will experience when coming to our property, which is usually pretty satisfying." ••

THE MAIN EVENT

MOON Struck

Furman University welcomed droves of stargazers to its South Carolina campus in August, with everyone intent on catching a glimpse of the Great American Eclipse.

There's nothing like a once-in-a-lifetime feat of nature to bring out the crowds. In August, Furman University welcomed more than 10,000 visitors and an additional 4,000 students, faculty, and staff that had recently returned for the school year to the Paladin Stadium to get a front-row seat to the first total solar eclipse since 1918. "It was an incredible thing to see, with all the people everywhere with glasses on viewing this great event," says Tony McGuirt, director of Younts Conference Center & Summer Programs at the university.

Located in Greenville, South Carolina, Furman was in the direct path of the eclipse as it traversed the United States and left viewers in the stadium in total blackout for a full two minutes. "We had the perfect weather for it, with completely clear skies," adds McGuirt, noting that in almost every aspect the event went off without a hitch.

A committee of 12 staff had been planning for the gathering since April. "We relied on our marketing com-

munications department to get the word out through news releases, social media, and our website," says McGuirt. The strategy worked so well that he says a large majority of the crowd was from out-of-state and he even ran into a family from London that had planned their U.S. holiday around the solar stunner. "I asked them how they found us and they said on the web, so we knew it was effective."

One of the biggest challenges in pre-

paring for the free viewing was trying to anticipate how many people would actually show up, particularly since Furman didn't have tickets or take any RSVPs. "We were anticipating up to 10,000 guests, but as the momentum built up, we began to realize it would probably be larger than that," says McGuirt. "So we had to be prepared for a 'sell out,' and anticipate what we would do if we ran out of parking, for example." In that case the plan would have been to close the gates and say the venue was at capacity. "But thankfully we actually never had to do that. We came close, but we could have put a few more in the [16,000-seat] stadium," he adds. "A lot of people chose to stay outside the stands and fill up the grassy areas, too."

Outside the stadium guests had plenty of events to occupy their time starting at noon, two hours before



the main event. "There were various booths, probably about 20, where people could buy food, kids could take part in STEM activities, and there were sponsors focused on health, climate science, and other topics," notes McGuirt who says the school provided water for all 14,000 guests due to the excessive heat on the day. The university also purchased 10,000 specially designed protective glasses, which could be picked up at various points on campus, allowing people to turn their eyes to the skies without risking any vision damage.

The main benefit of being inside the stadium though was the addition of Physics Professor David Moffett who emceed the event and provided in-depth commentary. "He was telling folks what was happening as time passed, what was happening in other states at various times, and really just walking everyone through the whole process," says McGuirt. "He was extremely informative." The jumbotron screens on the field also carried a live stream from NASA that gave the full grasp of the momentous event. "We wanted to make it entertaining and educational at the same time," admits McGuirt. Several students from Furman as well as nearby campuses



were also conducting experiments onsite, in an area separate from the crowd where they could gather data. Media, too, also came out in full force with Furman receiving coverage from local news stations like WUSA-9, WYFF-4, and national outlet Thrillist.

"It was a tremendous PR event for us as well," says McGuirt, further noting that the main goal for the staff was to make it a memorable experience for everyone involved. "One of our missions is to be part of the community and give back, and so we hope they enjoyed the day and walked away with a positive view of Furman and felt welcome to come back and share the word about us."

There is a good chance that could happen in seven years, if not before, as the next major eclipse crosses the same path in 2024. LV

From sports stadiums to a piano bar and thriving campus, these four venues provide ironclad reasons to visit Pittsburgh.



Unique Venues hosted its recent Annual Members Conference in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and we fell so in love with the city, its people and the great venues we just had to share these four top picks with you.

Heinz Field

As if being in a football stadium wasn't enough of a thrill, one of the coolest new venues at Heinz Field (home of the Pittsburgh Steelers) is the PNC Champions Club. This trendy spot features a full glass enclosure where attendees have a unique vantage point from the field's south end zone. "You can sit inside and be 5-10 feet off the grass and see the entire stadium," says Corporate Communications Manager Nick Sero. "It's turned into a great spot for events with a full view of the stadium

plus top shelf food and drink options."

PNC Champions Club is just one of many options for rental at the stadium, which is located in a prime spot along the Ohio River, just a bridge away from the downtown district. Large-scale events of up to 100,000 (utilizing the 68,000 seats inside and parking lots outside) are welcome as are small weddings and meetings that take place in suites, such as a recent 40-person meetup for a regional chapter of Coaches vs. Cancer. "We really do have a few different areas in the stadium

that are good for any size," says Sero.

He also touts the in-house catering as some of the best in all of sports. "We work with Aramark to do catering for all our events, and they prepare barbecue that is brined in-house and is really exceptional." Some of the other features groups can take advantage of are exclusive facility tours, alumni and player meet and greets, and large scoreboards and TVs inside all clubs and suites that can display logos, meeting schedules, or any other visuals a client may need.

"We are not just the home of the Steelers, but the home of Pittsburgh," says Sero. "Whatever the event is, the client will find the right spot for them."




University of Pittsburgh

The University of Pittsburgh has many of the amenities of a large campus, but there is one standout space that visitors always flock to: the Cathedral of Learning. It's the second tallest educational building in the world and plays host to a number of 'nationality rooms.' "Almost any country you can think of is represented," says Conference Services Manager Adrianne R. Holmes, noting that her department can also set up tours.

For visiting groups, Holmes and her team can help reserve space at the campus' University Club or the Petersen Events Center, both offering a unique layout of spaces. In the University Club, there are two ballrooms, four smaller breakout rooms, and a rooftop terrace with a view of the cathedral. There are also two on-site restaurants for convenient dining experiences. The Petersen Events Center is the university's sports facility with a 12,000seat multi-purpose arena for use as well as a handful of other smaller spaces.

regularly works with nearby hotels, including the Wyndham, Hilton Garden Inn, and Residence Inn Pittsburgh Oakland/University Place to secure room blocks and special rates for multi-day conference guests. Other perks of hosting a meeting at the university, she says, is, "We offer free Wi-Fi at the University Club, and there are food and beverage



minimums so that if a group spends a certain amount, the room rental is waived." Her department can also work with the parking office to reserve spots for conference guests. "We are a one-stop shop that's able to plan an entire conference so it's easier for a planner to navigate.

Howl at the Moon

Music can not only add ambiance to your next event, it can also be the main focus when you gather at Howl at the Moon. This high-energy live entertainment venue is one of 16 national locations (and on some cruise ships), located in Pittsburgh's cultural district. "We are within walking distance to the convention center and stadiums, so people can easily find us," says Sales & Event Manager Natalie Holoweckyj, noting that Howl at the Moon has quite the range for what it can host. "We can do just about everything, from luncheons to offering our stage for speakers, team-building activities, or the traditional nightlife experience. It really is customizable for each group."

Holoweckyj and her team can coordinate full buyouts for about 430 people or semi-private event space for a group as small as 10. Though the main floor is one

open room, the Moon Deck is another popular option that has an elevated area and private bar. The venue has full catering services (whether just apps or a complete dinner) and bar options including hourly drink packages and drink tickets. There are also A/V capabilities, including microphones and TV monitors for slideshows and logos.

Of course entertainment is the big draw here, and there are several packages groups can take advantage of, from setting up a dinner and dueling piano show to a more customized concert with a curated playlist of tracks. "Our musicians really can play everything," says Holoweckyj. For private events, planners can also fill out a questionnaire that allows the musician to play a song written just for the group. "We can also do something a bit more structured like a 'name that tune' game," she adds. "Our goal is to ensure everyone has a good time."

PNC Park

Enjoying a day at the park is a totally different ballgame when you're an attendee of an event rather than a spectator. "People always see a ballpark when it's full, but it's such a unique feeling and view when you


see it empty and can fully understand the magnitude of how big these places are," says Ann Elder Regan, Director of PNC Park Events.

As the home of the Pittsburgh Pirates, PNC Park has seen its share of exciting moments during the regular playing season and the off-season when some truly magical events take place. One of Elder's favorites was a few years ago when a client opted to utilize 90 percent of the park for one event. "We had a check presentation on the field, a private concert with a major music act, themed spaces and decorated hallways, and a formal dinner," she recalls. "We love when clients challenge us. Anything they want to try to do, we will do our best to make it happen."

One of the newest spaces is the Business Center, a versatile option with state-of-the-art A/V, its own private conference room, and reception space. The Hall of Fame Club and Lexus Club are two other popular choices that can be set up in a myriad of ways, each with a patio that overlooks the playing field and the city skyline. The park is actually located just outside the city proper with the benefit of accessible parking and close proximity to hotels and restaurants.

"They are looking for locally sourced foods, recyclable or compostable supplies, and menus that feature a local theme, and we are proud to serve the university community in this way."



Over the course of two summers, in 2016 and 2017, floors 2 through 18 were overhauled. The renovations included completely gutting the existing bathrooms and corridors. Bathrooms received new showers and toilet areas, updated vanity sinks, enhanced tiled floors and walls, and the addition of ADA/Gender Neutral facilities. New carpet, ceilings, and a fresh coat of paint were unveiled in all the corridors as well after the project was completed in August. "The major challenges in completing this project on schedule were coordinating and completing the required demolition (including asbestos abatement), while at the same time moving an enormous amount of materials for the renovation via three standard elevators," says Nichole M. Smithson with the Central Housing department. But in the end, she says, "We provided more privacy for students and guests



and enhanced the living experience for those who live and visit with us."

When it comes to a great reputation, a venue's work is not done with the accommodations or the catering or even when the meeting or event wraps. There's a great deal of attention paid to the work done outside of just the execution; we salute these four venues that have put in the extra work to also create user-friendly websites, engaging social media, and unique print ads and marketing collateral. Here's the best we've seen this year.

COLLATERAL Winner: SIMMONS COLLEGE (BOSTON, MA)

Simmons College is not a traditional venue—and the conferences and special events department knew that their promotional collateral couldn't be ordinary either. "I wanted to develop a marketing piece that was different, not a bi-fold brochure, or a packet that had loose pages that would fall out," says Nikki Vanderpol, director, conferences and special events. "I wanted to produce a piece that delivered the pertinent information in an easy-to-read, clear, concise format." To do so, Vanderpol and a colleague came

up with the idea to create a set of bright flash cards on heavy card stock that were held together by a ball-and-chain key ring, along with her business card as the perfect finishing touch.

"I believe that when a potential client is shopping around for a venue they are seeking out one that they can trust to execute all components of the event," adds Vanderpol. "With this in mind, I wanted the content of the piece to focus on four main messages." Each card features information on those individual points, including information about the college's over-the-top customer service and convenient one-stop shop operation as well as their commitment to work ethic. "I want recipients to know that we have knowledge of conference planning, and

also relay the message that our staff will take care of them and their guests, from the first point of contact to the final invoicing." The other two cards explain the college's ability to customize services and provide flexibility, and finally, tout the ideal location in Boston with a campus surrounded by Fenway Park, museums, and restaurants, and access to the downtown district.

The other added benefit is that this particular marketing collateral has a longer shelf life. "Our conference business changes over time," says Vanderpol, "and this design allows us to replace one card if needed, without having to reproduce the entire piece." Talk about a slam-dunk! McNamara Alumni Center's winning print ad grew out of the staff's love of basketball-and humor. "Because the Alumni Center is part of a Division 1 college campus at the University of Minnesota, March Madness is well-known and talked about in this community," says Director of Marketing & Sales Amy T. Leyden of the ad that ran for 30 days in March, right around the time of the popular competition. "And because I'm a huge college basketball fan and our small events team has a good sense of humor, I envisioned a 'McNamara Madness' booking promotion that featured our team in basketball uniforms superimposed upon a background of our gorgeous Memorial Hall."

To make the photo shoot work, Leyden borrowed basketballs and uniforms from the University of Minnesota Gophers men's team. "They agreed to let us remove the jerseys' names and numbers and replace them [respectively] with MCNAMARA and 20%," with the number identifying the ad's promotion for 20 percent off the rental rate when you book a room.

Leyden was not only the creative director for the piece but also the photographer. "Our team members lined up in front of black pipe and drape and gave his or her best 'attitude," she recalls. "That was the most fun—with many laughs—primar-



ily because our team is made up of such kind, customer-service-friendly people, so getting them to look tough and intimidating was hard for many of them!"

A graphic designer put the piece together in Photoshop and Leyden wrote coordinating copy that reflected basket-

ball lingo alongside the hashtag MACMAD to inspire social media posts. The ad was posted on the Alumni Center's website and social media pages, and sent electronically to a long client list. "Our clients found this campaign hilarious," admits Leyden. "We received many, many likes on the Facebook post and some clients requested posters for their offices. Best of all, it generated bookings."

their group market," says Couture. One of the other main benefits is that the website outlines easy steps for organizers that aren't necessarily professional planners. "We provided step-by-step guides for planning an event that are easy to understand and follow a natural flow," says Couture. The path starts at accommodations, then moves to venue choices listed by type of event, then food, amenities, and other activities.

Visuals were also important to the Conference Services department and one of the major upgrades was updating about 95 percent of the photos featured "to give a fresh and modern look to the website," notes Couture. "We wanted the photos to speak for themselves in order to avoid long text." The website also features a virtual venue tour video, created by Unique Venues, "so we could show our clients what their experience will be like," adds Couture.

Gaining followers on social media and keeping them engaged is no easy task nowadays as more and more accounts come online and more people turn to hashtags and retweets as a primary way of communicating. The way that Willowdale continues to make headway is by "focusing on the shared values with our customers," says Sarah Boucher, senior sales and marketing manager. "We like showcasing exceptional party experiences and event planning inspiration, as well as our excellent catering and historic location. We promote these shared values through video, photos, and text that will be compelling to our target audience of current and potential customers, past clients, neighbors, other event professionals, friends, and family members of our team."

Boucher says that her staff regularly posts on Pinterest, Facebook, Instagram,

LinkedIn, and Twitter. "The social channels that drive the most traffic to our website have been Pinterest and Facebook," she says, "and Instagram traffic is growing rapidly and we anticipate that with the added business features this platform will quickly become one of our favorite ways to connect with prospective clients."

In the past year, part of the team's emphasis has also been on high-quality engagement (such as getting more likes, comments, and shares) as well as conversions through social promotions. "We seek out new opportunities for engagement and encourage conversation and participation in the ways that are most natural for the user since each platform is different," adds Boucher.

For example, on Pinterest, she says, "Our goal is to reach our target cus-

tomer before they even start the search for a venue. We add images that have a mix of helpful keywords related to the image and location in the description to make sure that people using the search feature can find our page based on the kind of party they are planning, or the location of the event." On Facebook the idea is to create posts that are likely to encourage comments or shares. "Organic interest on Facebook can have a dramatic impact on brand awareness, referrals, and reaching a target audience without paying for ads. It also helps to encourage other businesses and individuals to connect through tagging our location, writing reviews, and posting photos," says Boucher, noting the team does use targeted ads from time to time based on posts that have already proven to do well. And Instagram, she says, "is the perfect platform for reaching new people and showcasing our best work in a visually compelling way. We've had a lot of suc-



cess connecting with industry partners, recently engaged couples, and locals through the use of our venue's location tag, relevant hashtags, and through following and building relationships with key influencers in our target audience."

As Willowdale heads into 2018, Boucher says the focus will be on increasing the frequency of posts for Pinterest and Instagram, and also creating video to share on Facebook and more promotional stories for Instagram. "We have also started to use the [social media organizing tool] Buffer this year and we are just loving the schedule feature," she says. PERSON OF INTEREST

PROFESSIONAL of the YEAR

With a successful career in collegiate conference and event services, Shane Cutler has shifted the tide at Boston University, discussing his team's biggest accomplishments in 2017 and what comes next.

Shane Cutler can't remember a time he wasn't immersed in the world of higher education. From starting his career as assistant director of student activities and Greek life at Plymouth State University to becoming the first director of the University of Vermont's Conference and Event Services department to his current role as general manager for Events & Conferences at Boston University, Cutler has made the campus home—not only for himself but also for the many groups that visit each year.

"Shane and his team have created an operation that is considered a benchmark in the collegiate conferencing industry," says Unique Venues President Chuck Salem of naming Cutler Professional of the Year. If the 2017 accomplishments are any indication, there are more good things ahead.

Unique Venues: What were some of the key moments for you and your staff this year? Shane Cutler: "One of the most exciting things is that we developed a departmental, five-year capital plan for renovations in all of our event venues. Another accomplishment is our marketing efforts. We now look at marketing as systematic, multi-faceted, multi-layered, and, whenever possible, personalized. We've made gains through SEO, social media, ad campaigns, full-out website designs, collateral, e-blasts, and outreach to our local chamber. We also have a better client feedback system, including meetings with our annual summer clients and a new online evaluation system, where we also provide gift cards upon completion. Lastly, we have launched an overnight housing reservation system to allow individuals that are part of a conference or event to reserve and pay on their own."

UV: What is the health of collegiate conference programs as we head into 2018? SC: "Very strong. As a whole, we offer truly unique spaces that clients are actively seeking, and we can do so in most cases for a great value, particularly for price-sensitive

clients. Given that our campuses are designed to support and deliver a product for degree-seeking students, we have access to a truly unique product, including state-of-theart classrooms and meeting facilities."

UV: What are some of the industry trends you and your team are identifying?

SC: "One thing we have noticed is that clients are busy and want to make quicker decisions, so we have found it important to have information readily available online, and have business systems in place to get back to clients very quickly with full pricing and availability. At times, clients also request to move to a contract without physically seeing a venue, which for us was a driving force in creating facility videos and an expanded online presence. On a more serious note, we also wonder how travel and immigration restrictions by the U.S. Government will impact international conference attendees and academic students as a whole."

UV: How can planners start to integrate with campuses more?

SC: "One of the values a campus offers is we don't just provide a venue for a meeting, but we can also offer additional services. Instead of sending staff to come onsite for check-in and actual management, they can outsource those needs with us and let us co-manage the program with them. It's not something a planner can find in all cases at a hotel or conference center."


